# Terms, conditions and privacy policy

## **Deposits**

A non refundable fee of £50 is required to secure your booking. Please note no booking has been made until this has been received and confirmed by myself. This will be deducted from the final payment due.

#### **Trials**

Bridal trials are imperative and held at my home in central Bath. There can be some flexibility on this depending on circumstances and strictly payable on the day of the trial. I recommend booking in for this at least 6-8 weeks in advance prior to the wedding or event. Prior to the trial please feel free to email me any pictures of yourself and ideas of what you are aiming for on the day. This gives me a start picture to build on in the trial where things can be finalised in detail. Timings, numbers and final costs will be determined at the trial. Payment on the day is strictly by cash or BACS transfer 24 hours prior to the event. Any additional costs incurred on the day are also payable by cash.

Travel costs may be incurred depending on travel time and distance but will be discussed at the trial. Accessible parking at the venue needs to be confirmed due to the amount of equipment I need to carry. If not available I may need to source alternative transport at your cost.

An additional 20% to be charged outside my advertised working hours.

### **Booking cancelations**

In the unfortunate event you need to cancel your booking, for whatever reason, cancellation fees are as follows

- 3 calendar months or less before the event 50% of total fee
- 2 calendar months or less before the event- 60% of total fee
- 1 month or less.- Full remaining fee

If you do need to cancel I will hold your deposit for another six months from the original booking date. Any other obligations after this time will be lost
